

PARENTS

Parents have a critical part in all our programs. In order for you child to get the most out of the AWANA program, your partnership with us is essential. Please support your child's interest in the program by helping with memorization at home, encouraging enthusiasm about AWANA and regular club attendance to grow your child's spiritual understanding through the scriptures.

DISCIPLINE

We expect all clubbers to participate in the activities and follow their leaders instructions to maximize enjoyment for everyone. We use a group 5-Count and a personal 3-Count to foster good order. If a child receives two 3-counts in an evening, after the third, the child's parents will be called to retrieve the child for the evening. The Awana Club Leadership will discuss the situation with the parents.

UNIFORMS

Uniforms are an important part of our club structure. We do expect clubbers to wear their **uniform** each night. This includes **athletic shoes** so that each child can safely play organized games each club night.

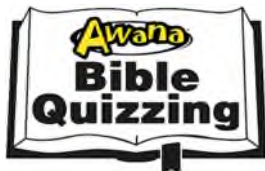

Cars **must** be completed by **Wednesday, Grand Prix Impound Night**, and **brought to club** to be inspected and placed in the **Impound Lot**.

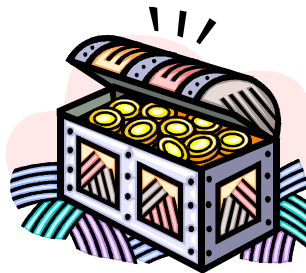
ADULT RACE—UNLIMITED CLASS!
